WELCOME BACK

It is so good to be able to open up Trinity Church again after a long enforced absence and we are looking forward to seeing those of you who feel able and comfortable in attending. We also send our greetings and prayers to those of our Church family who are still vulnerable and not yet able to join us.

We welcome Rev. David Lavender today as our new minister and a warm welcome also to his wife, Pam. We look forward to David's ministry and sharing worship with them.

Our services will be different to what we have been used to and as yet there is no Circuit Plan for preachers but David is taking our first service on **18th October** and we have some willing volunteers to lead worship for us as required. The service will last approx. 30 minutes and although Bill will play the organ, there will be no singing. We are planning to meet every 2 weeks initially and so the second service will be on 1st November.

Bibles and Hymn Books have been stored away to prevent cross contamination and we ask you to follow the guidance listed below to stay safe.

On arrival please wear your mask (unless exempt) and keep the 2m distance when coming in.

Use the hand sanitiser at the table in The Link and book in with your name and contact details or use the track & trace app before entering the church.

There is a one way system in place and the stewards will guide you on entering and leaving.

The chairs have been distanced but if you come as a family and are in a pod, they may be put together in that group but if they are moved make sure that the distancing from other chairs and groups is maintained.

The disabled toilet facility is open with sterile wipes and sanitisers to use. Paper towels are to be used instead of linen ones and these should be disposed of in the 72 hour covid quarantine bin provided.

When the service ends please stay in your seats until the stewards open the doors and show you which exit to use.

This seems like a lot of do's and don'ts, but it is for everyone's safety and that is

most important following the months of lockdown we have had.

We can accommodate 20 at present in Church and so you need to ring Lyn on 07866 058388 or 01952 825586 to see if there are spaces available before coming.

It will be so good to see you all again, even though we can't hug we will still be together as a Church Family!
